1. Code the following diagnostic terms using ICD- 10CM. Write the appropriate code next to the number of the statement/phrase in the ANSWER BOOK. <u>Each question carries 2 – marks</u>

- 1.1 Passenger in three-wheeled motor vehicle injured in collision with animal (nontraffic) –
- 1.2 Procreative counseling and advice using natural family planning.
- 1.3 Non-conclusive HIV-test findings in infants.
- 1.4 Passenger injured in the accidental derailment of the train.
- 1.5 Elevated fasting triglycerides.
- 1.6 A person has died from an acute transmural myocardial infarction of the anterior wall.
- 1.7 Presence of left artificial knee joint.
- 1.8 Gestational diabetes mellitus in pregnancy, diet controlled.
- 1.9 Patient presents with vascular dementia with behavioral disturbance.
- 1.10 Decompensated COPD with (acute) exacerbation.
- 1.11 Acute suppurative otitis media of right ear with recurrent rupture of the ear drum.
- 1.12 Laceration without foreign body of left front wall of thorax without penetration into thoracic cavity.
- 1.13 Acute influenza upper respiratory infection due to Avian flu.
- 1.14 Chronic hyperplastic gingivitis.
- 1.15 Encounter for examination of the potential donor of organ and tissue.
- 1.16 Congenital red cell aplastic anemia.
- 1.17 Displaced fracture of proximal phalanx of right great toe, initial encounter for closed fracture.
- 1.18 A patient was admitted for treatment of his hemiplegia on the left dominant side.
- 1.19 As a result of a blood transfusion, a patient develops streptococcal septicaemia.
- 1.20 Alcoholic cirrhosis of liver.

- 2.3 What is the correct code for Type 2 Diabetic Gastroparesis in a patient who requires long-term use of Insulin to control their Diabetes?
- 2.4 Twin pregnancy, one placenta, two amniotic sacs, third trimester with the complication of gestational hypertension.
- 2.5 What are the correct diagnosis codes to report an encounter for screening a mammogram on a patient at high risk for breast cancer due to a history of breast cancer in the patient's sister?

Using chapter specific guidelines, identify the most suitable codes from ICD -10 CM by for the following scenarios. Write the appropriate code next to the number of the statement/phrase in the ANSWER Booklet. <u>Each question carries 10 - marks</u>

3.1 During a routine prenatal visit, Mrs. Ima, 35 year old, G1, P1 at 18 weeks of pregnancy underwent a 1-hour glucose screening test that was found to be abnormal, with a blood sugar level reported to be over 200 mg/dl. The patient was sent to the hospital laboratory for a 3-hour glucose tolerance test. The final diagnosis is Gestational Diabetes.

3.2 A 4-year-old old male is brought in by his mother. She states he fell out of a swing at the park and complained of his ankle hurting. Some swelling of the right ankle is noted but no signs of fracture. Diagnosis: Sprained right ankle.

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- 3.3 Mr Mathew 21-year-old driver of a car collided with a pickup truck on the interstate highway. The driver confessed to using his cell phone to send a text message to his girlfriend.
- 3.4 A single new-born was born vaginally in the hospital. The baby is being treated for Rh incompatibility. The baby has type A+ blood and the mother is A-. What are the correct diagnosis code(s)?
