

- 1. Read the following statements about assessment in education. Indicate <u>true</u> if you agree with the statement and <u>false</u> if you don't agree. (11 x 2 =22)
- 1.1 Learning Classroom Assessment Techniques (CATs) evaluate learning strategies outside the classroom.
- 1.2 According to the behaviourism learning theory, knowledge exists inside the student.
- 1.3 Social constructivists believe that knowledge is constructed (developed) through interaction with others.
- 1.4 While behaviourism and cognitivism learning theories place the focus on the student, humanism places the focus on the teacher.
- 1.5 The Internet is a network of computers and the same devices all connected together.
