- 1.2 Atrophic age-related macular degeneration.
- 1.3 Subdural hemorrhage accompanying tentorial tear.
- 1.4 Sleep-related bruxism.
- 1.5 Preglaucoma, unspecified, right eye.
- 1.6 Car passenger injured in collision with bus in traffic accident.
- 1.7 Hungry bone syndrome.
- 1.8 Diabetes with diabetic amyotrophy.
- 1.9 Congenital non-neoplastic nevus.
- 1.10 Hypertensive heart disease with heart failure.
- 1.11 Malignant neoplasm of upper-outer quadrant of left female breast.
- 1.12 Newborn esophageal reflux.

2. Identify the most suitable codes from ICD -10 CM by using chapter specific guidelines for the following conditions. Write the appropriate code next to the number of the statement/phrase in the ANSWER Booklet. Each question carries 4 - marks

- 2.1 This 78-year-old gentleman is seen for continued follow-up for *C. diff colitis*. Cultures of the organism have found this infection to be resistant to flagyl. A new drug regimen will be started at this time. What is the correct diagnosis code assignment?
- 2.2 Mrs Mari is in her second trimester at 16 weeks presents for a check-up. She is HIV positive. What are the diagnosis codes?
- 2.3 A ventilator-dependent patient (due to COPD with emphysema) is admitted to the hospital for dehydration. IV fluids are started for hydration and the patient is placed on the hospital's ventilator. What is the appropriate diagnosis code assignment?
- 2.4 A patient is admitted to the hospital with acute diastolic heart failure due to hypertension with end stage renal disease (ESRD).
- 2.5 Acute cerebral infarction, thrombosis of the left anterior cerebral artery with residual right-sided hemiplegia.

Using chapter specific guidelines, identify the most suitable codes from ICD -10 CM by for the following Scenarios. Write the appropriate code next to the number of the statement/phrase in the ANSWER Booklet. <u>Each question carries 10 - marks</u>

3.1 A 24-year-old woman with a history of *Chlamydia* two years ago comes in requesting an IUD. Examination is normal but tested for *Chlamydia* and a pap smear is done. IUD was inserted with no problems noted.

- 3.2 This 46-year-old male, working on his own home improvement projects, fell from a ladder outside of his single-family home. After evaluation, it was determined that he had a non-displaced femoral neck fracture on the left side. At this time, no surgical intervention is planned. What diagnosis codes are assigned?
- 3.3 A routine follow up visit for a 29 year old Type II diabetic patient in her 2nd trimester at 15 weeks of pregnancy. She administers insulin once per day.
- 3.4 The patient is seen for evaluation of his continuing unstable angina. After significant evaluation, his symptoms were found to be due to atherosclerosis of his bypassed graft. This is an autologous arterial graft. Final diagnosis: CAD of bypass graft with unstable angina and hypertensive congestive heart failure. The patient will be scheduled for surgery. What is the correct diagnosis code(s)?
