- 3.1 45-year-old male diagnosed with small cell carcinoma of the left upper lobe of lung with metastasis to the intrathoracic lymph nodes and left rib. Seen today because of severe anemia. Client continues to smoke cigarettes-1 pack/day.
- 3.2 A 46-year-old male, working on his own home improvement projects, falls from a ladder outside of his single-family home. After evaluation, it is determined that he has a non-displaced femoral neck fracture on the left side. At this time, no surgical intervention is planned. What diagnosis codes are assigned?

- 3.3 A 75-year-old female was brought to the ER with severe difficulty in breathing. She was intubated started on mechanical ventilation and admitted. Diagnosis for this patient: Acute respiratory failure, acute infectious bronchitis with acute exacerbation of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. What diagnosis codes are assigned?
- 3.4 A 38-year-old female was seen last week for annual examination. Blood work is consistent with Hypercholesterolaemia. She returns today for follow-up and is given a prescription for Pravastatin. Since she is a Type 2 diabetic on insulin, her blood sugar is checked and is 140mg/dl. She is obese at 240 pounds with a BMI of 41. Dietary counselling was provided.
