#### **QUESTION 1**

**Inclusiveness** is one of the foundations of the **Harambee Prosperity Plan**. Articulate how the President of Namibia **should deal** with the following challenges:

- a) Former South West African and Koevoet soldiers are not recognised as Veterans and do not receive benefits in terms of once off pay-outs, Veteran Allowances and project financing.
- b) Populist tendencies for the nationalisation of mines.
- c) Predatory elites enrich themselves at the expense of the majority.
- d) Industry and academic contributions are not valued by Government.
- e) Almost one million Namibians are living in shacks. Local authorities are controlling the availability of urban land and created a scarcity of serviced land. A shortage of at least 300 000 houses exist. (25)
