- 3.2 15-year-old client is having difficulty breathing. She has AIDS and is 13 weeks pregnant. This is her first pregnancy. Workup reveals Pneumocystitis carinii pneumonia.
- 3.3 43-year-old obese female with secondary diabetes mellitus due to acute idiopathic pancreatitis. She has been on insulin for 3 years and today her blood sugar is 300 mg/dl. Height – 5’4 inches, Weight – 190 lbs.
- 3.4 57-year-old male has Hypertension with Stage 4 chronic kidney disease. He walked into clinic reporting blood in urine and severe lower abdominal pain. Urine was positive for heavy blood and abdomen is distended. Emergency medical service was called.
