- 1.11 Learning of Classroom Assessment Techniques should be conducted after a test or an assignment.

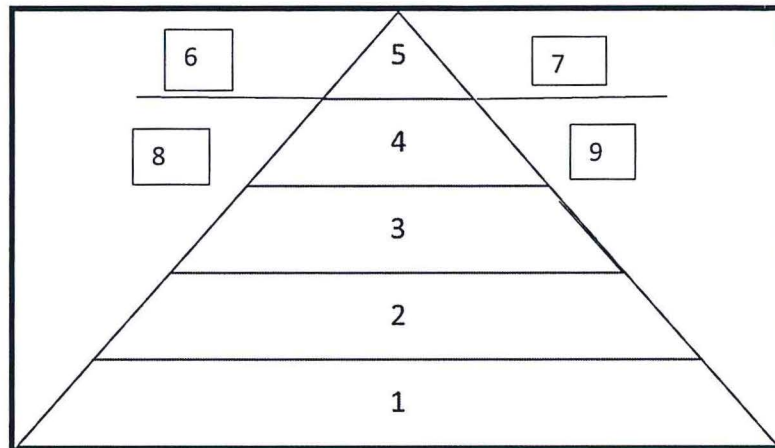
2. Provide an example of learning which supports the definition of learning according to the theory of behaviourism? (4)
