Using appropriate industry examples, distinguish between a code of conduct and a code of ethics. Which would you prefer to implement, and why? Your answer should include:

- (a) A definition of the two codes, and how to distinguish one from the other (2x2=4)
- (b) Which of the two codes you would prefer for your business or personal practice. Justify your preference on the strength of comparison with the type of code you would prefer <u>not</u> to use. (4.5+4.5 = 9)
- (c) Draft a media/communication industry code of conduct <u>and</u> a code of ethics (two documents) with a minimum of five guidelines apiece. The two codes should be drafted in such a way that they demonstrate the distinctions between a code of ethics and a code of conduct (2x6=12)

Discuss three statutes that govern the operations of  $\underline{\text{state-owned media}}$  in Namibia. (3x8 marks = 24 marks + one bonus mark for language)
